CLEAN STOCK/VIRUS X TESTED:

We test all lots for virus X in the field and also before planting. We have been very isolated from potential infection, having propagated our own stocks instead of bringing in material from Holland.

VARIETIES AND DESCRIPTIONS

EARTH ANGEL: Large, heartshaped blue-green leaves with creamy white margins. Pale lavender flowers in July.

FRAGRANT DREAM: Dark green leaves with a narrow, light yellow border form a wide mound. Very fragrant near-white flowers appear in July.

HALCYON: Thick spear shaped blue leaves. Abundant bluish flowers. Groundcover medium sized.

HYACINTHINA: Bluish green glaucous foliage. Very rugged groundcover type/medium sized plant.

KROSSA REGAL: Frosty blue leaves. Upright vase plant form. Medium to large sized plants.

PATRIOT: Large leaves with white edges. Lavender flowers in midsummer.

REGAL SPLENDOR: Blue green foliage surrounded by creamy gold edges. Lavender flowers in midsummer.

ROYAL STANDARD: Glassy green leaves and huge fragrant white flowers. Great as background, large sized plant.

SIEBOLDIANA ELEGANS: Very large, blue-green, seersucker (puckered) leaves. The standard of blue hostas and still hard to beat. Specimen or background/large sized plant.

STAINED GLASS: Bright golden yellow leaf center and dark green margins. Large, fragrant, near white flowers in August.

WIDE BRIM: Winner of the "Garden of Merit" from the Royal Hosta Societ. Heart-shaped leaves with blue-green centers and wide, irregular cream-colored borders. Light-lavender to white flowers.

AVAILABLE: Only ship dates: July 29, August 19 and September 9, 2019

MINIMUM: 500 DIVISIONS – 10 box minimum on fresh dug Hostas.

HOSTA FOR FALL 2019

Field digging in July for immediate shipping. Due to non-dormant nature of plants, we will ship as soon as processed. We will not store for later shipments.

HOSTA GRADING - When people talk eyes and Hostas, are they talking side eyes or center eyes? We're confused, so we thought a picture would help. Many side eyes, which become quite large, aren't even visible when we are dividing. Our single crown division is 1.2 to 1.5 cm diameter at the base on Albo Marginata, about 30% smaller on Albo Picta. We ship a larger #1 division than you receive out of Holland, but we don't count eyes. Some varieties will have more side eyes than others. We leave about 5 inches of root to ensure a strong start.
